Off-duty these special officers are docile and sweet and love to play, but on duty, just the presence of the canines will often lead to the suspect(s) giving up before a canine goes in to apprehend. The handlers warn the suspects that a canine is about to hunt for them. When necessary, these young canines are just as happy to go in and apprehend the suspects.

Suspects with a bent for narcotics are likely to meet up with Buddy and his handler, Officer Kim Lawrence. Buddy is GPD's four-year-old black Labrador. His abilities encompass sniffing out six different types of narcotics. Buddy often goes into very dangerous situations, such as raids involving suspected narcotics deals. Remember, these highly-trained dogs are sworn officers of the law and wear the same police badges as their handlers.
